AN ACT

Amending the act of October 30, 1996 (P.L.732, No.131), entitled 1 2 "An act establishing grounds upon which innkeepers may deny 3 accommodations, facilities or privileges of a lodging establishment to any person who is unable or unwilling to pay 4 5 for accommodations and services, to any person who is б disorderly, to any person who an innkeeper reasonably 7 believes is seeking accommodations for any unlawful purpose and to any person who an innkeeper reasonably believes is 8 9 bringing upon the lodging establishment property which may be 10 dangerous to other persons; allowing an innkeeper to limit the number of persons who shall occupy any particular guest 11 room of a lodging establishment; providing for the posting of 12 13 notice relative to this statute; and providing for 14 penalties," providing for prospective employee background 15 checks.

16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

17 hereby enacts as follows:

18 Section 1. The act of October 30, 1996 (P.L.732, No.131),

19 known as the Pennsylvania Innkeepers' Rights Act, is amended by

20 adding a section to read:

21 <u>Section 7.1. Background checks.</u>

1	(a) General ruleAn innkeeper shall require an individual
2	applying for employment with a lodging establishment who would
3	have access to guest room keys if employed to undergo a check of
4	criminal history record information.
5	(b) Criminal history record informationNotwithstanding
6	the provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. § 9121(b)(2) (relating to general
7	regulations), an innkeeper who requests a check of criminal
8	history record information shall be entitled to receive
9	notations of arrests, indictments and other information relating
10	to the initiation of criminal proceedings occurring within seven
11	years from the date of the request.
12	(c) Use of informationWhenever an innkeeper is in receipt
13	of information which is part of an individual's criminal history
14	record information file, the innkeeper may use that information
15	for the purposes of deciding whether or not to hire the
16	applicant only in accordance with 18 Pa.C.S. § 9125 (relating to
17	use of records for employment) and shall provide the applicant
18	notice regarding a decision not to hire as provided in 18
19	<u>Pa.C.S. § 9125(c).</u>
20	(d) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "check of
21	criminal history record information" means a criminal history
22	record check under 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 91 (relating to criminal
23	history record information) or a substantially equivalent system
24	of checking of criminal history record information as determined
25	by the Pennsylvania State Police, a list of which the
26	<u>Pennsylvania State Police shall publish in the Pennsylvania</u>
27	Bulletin annually.
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
