## AN ACT

Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania

10 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

11 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:

14 "Income." Includes compensation for services, including, but 15 not limited to, wages, salaries, bonuses, fees, compensation in 16 kind, commissions and similar items; income derived from

business; gains derived from dealings in property; interest; 1 rents; royalties; dividends; annuities; income from life 2 3 insurance and endowment contracts; all forms of retirement; 4 pensions; income from discharge of indebtedness; distributive 5 share of partnership gross income; income in respect of a decedent; income derived from the principal of an inheritance or 6 estate; income from an interest in an estate or trust; military 7 8 retirement benefits; railroad employment retirement benefits; social security benefits; temporary and permanent disability 9 benefits; workers' compensation; unemployment compensation; 10 11 other entitlements to money or lump sum awards, without regard to source, including lottery winnings; income tax refunds; 12 13 insurance compensation or settlements; awards or verdicts; and 14 any form of payment due to and collectible by an individual 15 regardless of source.
