AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," further providing for reporting by candidate and political committees and other persons.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section $1626(a)$ (b) (1) and (i) of the act of
June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania
Election Code, added October 4, 1978 (P.L.893, No.171) and July
21, 1979 (P.L.189, No.63), are amended to read:
Section 1626. Reporting by Candidate and Political
Committees and other Persons.--
(a) Each treasurer of a political committee and each

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contributions to more than one political committee for any
primary, general or special election, then receipts and
expenditures shall be reported by the contributing committee at
the same time as required by law for the committee receiving
same.
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    Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
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
