4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 4903(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
б	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 4903. False swearing.
8	(a) False swearing in official mattersA person who makes
9	a false statement under oath or equivalent affirmation, or
10	swears or affirms the truth of such a statement previously made,
11	when he does not believe the statement to be true is guilty of a
12	misdemeanor of the second degree if any of the following
13	paragraphs apply:
14	(1) [the] The falsification occurs in an official
15	<pre>proceeding[; or].</pre>
16	(2) [the] <u>The</u> falsification is intended to mislead a
17	public servant in performing his official function.

1	(3) The falsification is intended to mislead
2	shareholders or the public about the true financial condition
3	of the corporation and is included in:
4	(i) a report under 15 Pa.C.S. § 1554 (relating to
5	financial reports to shareholders) or 5553 (relating to
6	annual report of directors or other body); or
7	(ii) a document required to be filed with a Federal
8	or Commonwealth agency.

10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
