- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 3 selling or furnishing liquor or malt or brewed beverages to 4 minors. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 6310.1(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: Selling or furnishing liquor or malt or brewed 10 beverages to minors. (c) Minimum penalty. -- In addition to any other penalty

- 13 imposed pursuant to this title or other statute, a person who is
- 14 convicted of violating subsection (a) shall be sentenced to pay
- 15 a fine of not less than [\$1,000] \$2,500 and a term of
- imprisonment of up to 30 days for the first violation and a fine 16
- of [\$2,500] \$5,000 and a term of imprisonment of up to 90 days 17
- for each subsequent violation. There shall be no authority in 18

- 1 any court to impose on an offender any lesser sentence than the
- 2 minimum sentence mandated by this subsection. No court shall
- 3 have the authority to suspend any sentence as defined in this
- 4 section. Nothing in this section shall prevent the sentencing
- 5 court from imposing a sentence greater than the minimum sentence
- 6 mandated in this subsection. In no case shall the sentence
- 7 exceed the maximum sentence prescribed by law.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
