- 8 § 2707.1. Deployed Pennsylvania National Guard members.
- 9 (a) Eligibility. -- The commission or a county treasurer shall
- 10 <u>issue one annual resident fishing license at a cost of \$1 to a <-</u>
- 11 member of the Pennsylvania National Guard when:
- 12 (1) The member is eligible for a resident fishing
