AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for scattering 3 rubbish. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6501(a)(3) and (b)(5) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8 § 6501. Scattering rubbish. Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of an offense if 10 he: 11 12 (3) is the owner or operator, or an agent of either, of 13 a [trash, garbage or debris collection vehicle, including private automobiles and small trucks, or any other type of 14 vehicles used to collect or transport] vehicle used, for 15 profit or not for profit, in the collection or transportation 16

- deposited or deposits the vehicle's load or any part thereof
- 3 upon any road, street, highway, alley or railroad right-of-

- 8 (5) Any vehicle, equipment or conveyance, including any
- 9 private automobile and small truck, <u>may be deemed contraband</u>

- (i) in an amount exceeding 25 pounds, in the
- commission of an offense under subsection (a)(3); or
