AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, imposing sanctions on employers who
- 3 engage in the unlawful employment of aliens.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7331. Unlawful employment of aliens.
- 9 An employer who is found by a court or administrative agency
- 10 to have violated section 274A of the Immigration and Nationality
- 11 Act (66 Stat. 163, 8 U.S.C. § 1324a) shall be subject to the
- 12 suspension or revocation of its business or professional license
- 13 by the applicable licensing authority.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
