- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, defining "incident," "incident area" and "incident
- 3 clearance"; and providing for duties of drivers approaching
- 4 accident or incident scene.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 9 § 102. Definitions.
- 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 11 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 12 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
- 13 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 14 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:
- 15 * * *
- 16 "Incident." An emergency road user occurrence, a natural
- 17 <u>disaster or a special event.</u>
- 18 "Incident area." An area of a highway where authorized

- 1 officials impose a temporary traffic control zone in response to
- 2 an incident.
- 3 <u>"Incident clearance." The process of highway crash</u>
- 4 clearance, removing wreckage, debris or any other matter that
- 5 disrupts the normal flow of traffic and restoring roadway
- 6 capacity to its pre-incident condition. The term includes
- 7 temporary repair to the infrastructure.
- 8 * * *
- 9 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 10 § 3745.2. Duties of drivers approaching accident or incident
- 11 <u>scene</u>.
- 12 (a) General rule. -- When in or approaching an incident area,
- 13 <u>a driver shall obey the direction of any authorized official</u>
- 14 <u>directing traffic and all applicable traffic control devices.</u>
- (b) Authorized towing and recovery functions. -- When directed
- 16 by a police officer, towing and recovery service providers are
- 17 <u>authorized to perform the following enumerated functions and any</u>
- 18 other actions reasonably necessary to perform those enumerated
- 19 functions:
- 20 (1) Removal of vehicles from the incident area.
- 21 (2) Protection of property and vehicles.
- 22 (3) Removal of debris from the roadway.
- 23 (4) Transportation of persons or cargo.
- 24 (c) Incident clearance. -- Towing and recovery service
- 25 providers acting as responders to an incident when a police
- 26 officer is present in the incident area shall remain at least 50
- 27 feet from any vehicle or wreckage involved in the incident and
- 28 shall not proceed with incident clearance until directed by a
- 29 police officer.
- 30 (d) Penalty.--Any person violating this section commits a

- 1 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 2 <u>a fine of not more than \$500.</u>
- 3 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
