- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for permits for movement of a
- 3 mobile home or a modular housing unit and modular housing
- 4 undercarriage.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 4973 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:
- 9 § 4973. Permits for movement of a mobile home or a modular
- 10 housing unit and modular housing undercarriage.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (f) Authorization to move empty modular undercarriages.--The
- 13 department shall issue permits under this section for movement,
- 14 24 hours a day, seven days a week, of empty modular
- 15 undercarriages. However, in no event shall a permit for empty
- 16 modular undercarriages be issued for movement during a holiday
- 17 period or during inclement weather as defined by department

- 1 regulations. Up to two THREE empty modular undercarriages may be <---
- 2 <u>stacked on top of another undercarriage for movement if they are</u>
- 3 <u>securely fastened</u>.
- 4 (q) Return trip permit. -- A permit to transport an oversized
- 5 modular unit under this section may authorize a return trip to
- 6 transport empty modular undercarriages if the return trip is
- 7 <u>specifically indicated on the permit.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
