AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for certain duty for
- 3 emergencies.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 508 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 508. Active [State] duty for emergency.
- 9 (a) State duty.--The Governor may place the Pennsylvania
- 10 National Guard, or any part thereof, or when unavailable due to
- 11 call or order into the service of the United States, the
- 12 Pennsylvania Guard, or any part thereof, on active duty when an
- 13 emergency in this Commonwealth occurs or is threatened, or when
- 14 tumult, riot or disaster shall exist or is imminent.

- 1 (b) Emergency duty under compact. -- The Governor may place
- 2 the Pennsylvania National Guard, or any part thereof, on State
- 3 active duty, or, when appropriate, federally funded duty under
- 4 32 U.S.C. (relating to National Guard), when the Governor of
- 5 another state has declared an emergency and has requested the
- 6 assistance of the Pennsylvania National Guard under the
- 7 provisions of Chapter 45 (relating to interstate compact) or 35
- 8 Pa.C.S. Ch. 76 (relating to emergency management assistance
- 9 <u>compact</u>).
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
