AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the illegal dumping of  
3 methamphetamine waste.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 3311. Illegal dumping of methamphetamine waste.

9 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits a felony of the third  
10 degree if he knowingly deposits on any property a precursor  
11 substance, chemical waste or debris, used in or resulting from  
12 the manufacture of methamphetamine or the preparation of a  
13 precursor substance for the manufacture of methamphetamine.

14 (b) Exceptions.--Subsection (a) does not apply to the  
15 disposal of waste products:

16 (1) by a licensed pharmaceutical company in the normal

1     course of business; or  
2             (2) pursuant to Federal or State laws regulating the  
3     cleanup or disposal of waste products from unlawful  
4     manufacturing of methamphetamine.

5     Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
