## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 7, 2005 (P.L. , No.1A), entitled "An 2 act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for 5 the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 30, 2006, for certain institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 ending June 30, 2005; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, the Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores 10 11 Fund, the Milk Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust 12 Fund, the Emergency Medical Services Operating Fund, the 13 Tuition Payment Fund, the Banking Department Fund, the 14 Firearm Records Check Fund, the Ben Franklin Technology Development Authority Fund, the Tobacco Settlement Fund, the 15 16 Health Care Provider Retention Account and the Community 17 Health Reinvestment Restricted Account to the Executive 18 Department; to provide appropriations from the Judicial 19 Computer System Augmentation Account to the Judicial 20 Department for the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 30, 21 2006; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund 22 for the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 30, 2006, for the proper operation of the several departments of the 23 24 Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State Police authorized to 25 spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive Department of 26 the Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted 27
