Amending the act of July 7, 2005 (P.L. , No.1A), entitled "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 2 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 30, 2006, for certain institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 6 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, the Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores 10 11 Fund, the Milk Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust 12 Fund, the Emergency Medical Services Operating Fund, the Tuition Payment Fund, the Banking Department Fund, the 13 14 Firearm Records Check Fund, the Ben Franklin Technology 15 Development Authority Fund, the Tobacco Settlement Fund, the Health Care Provider Retention Account and the Community 16 17 Health Reinvestment Restricted Account to the Executive 18 Department; to provide appropriations from the Judicial 19 Computer System Augmentation Account to the Judicial 20 Department for the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 30, 2006; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund 21 22 for the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 30, 2006, for the 23 proper operation of the several departments of the 24 Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State Police authorized to 25 spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the

appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive Department of 1 2 the Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted receipt accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 2005, to June 3 30, 2006, and for the payment of bills remaining unpaid at 4 5 the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005; to provide 6 for the additional appropriation of Federal and State funds 7 from the General Fund and the Motor License Fund, for the 8 Executive and Legislative Departments of the Commonwealth for 9 the fiscal year July 1, 2004, to June 30, 2005, and for the 10 payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004," ADDING AN 11 APPROPRIATION TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO 12 13 COUNTIES FOR EXPENSES FOR FULL-TIME DISTRICT ATTORNEYS; AND 14 increasing the State appropriation to the Pennsylvania 15 Housing Finance Agency for the Homeowner's Emergency Mortgage 16 Assistance Program. 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1.
