## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- 3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth, providing for continuation
- 4 of demonstration projects for cardiac care.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 8 as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 9 read:
- 10 Section 1002.1. Continuation of Demonstration Projects for
- 11 Cardiac Care. -- Any hospital that is subject to the provisions of
- 12 this act, which also operates a demonstration project for
- 13 percutaneous coronary intervention, shall, upon expiration of
- 14 the demonstration project period initially approved by the
- 15 Department of Health, receive permanent approval of the service
- 16 operated under the demonstration project in accordance with the

- 1 conditions as initially approved, unless otherwise agreed to in
- 2 writing by the hospital. Nothing in this section shall prevent
- 3 the Department of Health from promulgating regulations regarding
- 4 percutaneous coronary intervention.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
