AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 collection of restitution, reparation, fees, costs, fines and
- 4 penalties.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 9728(g) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 9728. Collection of restitution, reparation, fees, costs,
- 10 fines and penalties.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (g) Costs, etc.--Any sheriff's costs, filing fees and costs
- 13 of the county probation department, clerk of courts or other
- 14 appropriate governmental agency, including, but not limited to,
- 15 any reasonable administrative costs associated with the
- 16 collection of restitution, transportation costs and other costs

- 1 <u>associated with the prosecution</u>, shall be borne by the defendant
- 2 and shall be collected by the county probation department or
- 3 other appropriate governmental agency along with the total
- 4 amount of the judgment and remitted to the appropriate agencies
- 5 at the time of or prior to satisfaction of judgment.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
