5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 1207(1) of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 1207. Regulatory authority of board.
10	The board shall have the power and its duties shall be to:
11	(1) Deny, deny the renewal, revoke, condition or suspend
12	any license or permit provided for in this part if the board
13	finds in its sole discretion that [a]:
14	<u>(i) A</u> licensee or permittee under this part, or its
15	officers, employees or agents, have furnished false or

1 misleading information to the board or failed to comply 2 with the provisions of this part or the rules and 3 regulations of the board and that it would be in the public interest to deny, deny the renewal, revoke, 4 5 condition or suspend the license or permit. (ii) A licensee or permittee conducts the operations 6 7 for which the license or permit was granted or intends to conduct the operations for which the license or permit is 8 9 sought in a keystone opportunity zone as defined under section 103 of the act of October 6, 1998 (P.L.705, 10 No.92), known as the Keystone Opportunity Zone, Keystone 11 12 Opportunity Expansion Zone and Keystone Opportunity

13 Improvement Zone Act.
