- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1327.1 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added
- 11 December 21, 1988 (P.L.468, No.192), is amended by adding a
- 12 subsection to read:
- 13 Section 1327.1. Home Education Program. -- * * *
- 14 (f.2) The school district of residence shall provide access
- 15 to libraries within the district to students taught in a home
- 16 education program AND HOME EDUCATION SUPERVISORS for the purpose

- 1 of borrowing scholastic materials. School districts providing
- 2 <u>library access may designate specific time periods in which</u>
- 3 persons educated in home education programs are permitted to use
- 4 their facilities.
