9	Section 701. Federal funds.

16	in this act are not necessary for the proper design, acquisition

18	required may be allocated by the Department of Transportation to
19	increase the estimated costs of any one or more of the projects
20	specifically itemized in a capital budget.
21	Section 703. Estimated useful life.
22	The General Assembly states that the estimated useful life of
23	the highway capital projects itemized in this act is 30 years.
24	Section 704. Effective date.
25	This act shall take effect immediately.
