A RESOLUTION

1	Designating June 10, 2005, as "Ukrainian Day" in Pennsylvania.
2	WHEREAS, Eight hundred ninety-two thousand nine hundred and
3	twenty-two persons living in the United States report that part
4	of their ancestry is Ukrainian; and
5	WHEREAS, Two hundred seventy-five thousand one hundred and
6	fifty-three persons living in the United States list the Ukraine
7	as their place of birth; therefore be it
8	RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
9	Commonwealth of Pennsylvania designate June 10, 2005, as
10	"Ukrainian Day" in Pennsylvania.
