A RESOLUTION

- 1 Declaring the week of January 29 through February 4, 2006, as 2 "Catholic Schools Week" in this Commonwealth.
- 3 WHEREAS, Catholic schools in this Commonwealth are
- 4 celebrating "Catholic Schools Week" from January 29 through
- 5 February 4, 2006; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Catholic elementary and secondary schools, educating
- 7 183,628 students annually, save State and local taxpayers more
- 8 than \$1 billion each year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Catholic schools instill in young people a strong
- 10 foundation of values, self-esteem, self-confidence and
- 11 leadership skills; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Catholic schools, in providing young people with
- 2 solid values and academic skills needed in becoming responsible
- 3 citizens of this Commonwealth and nation, have a dropout rate of
- 4 less than 3% and a postgraduate higher education enrollment rate
- 5 of 80%; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare the week
- 7 of January 29 through February 4, 2006, as "Catholic Schools
- 8 Week" in this Commonwealth and express congratulations and
- 9 appreciation to Catholic elementary and secondary schools across
