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AN ACT

Providing for the display of the American flag, Commonwealth

2 3	flag or military flag by residents in a unit owners association, homeowners association or master association.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Short title.
7	This act shall be known and may be cited as the American,
8	Commonwealth and Military Flag Act.
9	Section 2. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
11	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
12	context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	"American flag." The flag of the United States, as defined
14	in 4 U.S.C. § 1 (relating to flag; stripes and stars on) and the
15	Executive Orders entered in connection with that section, made
16	of fabric, cloth or paper displayed from a staff or flagpole or
17	in a window. The term does not include a depiction or emblem of

the American flag made of lights, paint, roofing, siding, paving
materials, flora or balloons, or any other similar building,
landscaping or decorative component.

"Association." Any unit owners association in a common 4 5 interest community, including all condominium, planned community <----or cooperative associations, as defined in 68 Pa.C.S. §§ 3103 6 7 (relating to definitions), 4103 (relating to definitions) and 5103 (relating to definitions), or in any successor statute. 8 9 "Common element." Any common element in a common interest 10 community, as defined in 68 Pa.C.S. §§ 3103 (relating to 11 definitions), 4103 (relating to definitions) and 5103 (relating 12 to definitions), or in any successor statute. COMMUNITY. <-13 "COMMON INTEREST COMMUNITY." INCLUDES A COOPERATIVE, A 14 CONDOMINIUM AND A PLANNED COMMUNITY WHERE AN INDIVIDUAL BY 15 VIRTUE OF AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN ANY PORTION OF REAL ESTATE IS 16 OR MAY BECOME OBLIGATED BY COVENANT, EASEMENT OR AGREEMENT 17 IMPOSED UPON THE OWNER'S INTEREST TO PAY ANY AMOUNT FOR REAL 18 PROPERTY TAXES, INSURANCE, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, MANAGEMENT, ADMINISTRATION OR REGULATION OF ANY PART OF THE REAL 19 20 ESTATE OTHER THAN THE PORTION OR INTEREST OWNED SOLELY BY THE 21 INDIVIDUAL.

22 "Commonwealth flag." The flag of the Commonwealth as described in section 1 of the act of June 13, 1907 (P.L.560, 23 24 No.373), entitled "An act designating the official flag of the 25 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and describing the same; providing for the carrying of such flag by the regiments of the National 26 27 Guard of Pennsylvania; authorizing the Secretary of the Commonwealth to provide, and have deposited in the office of 28 29 Secretary of the Commonwealth, a model of said flag, and making 30 an appropriation therefor." depiction or emblem of the flag of the Commonwealth made of
lights, paint, roofing, siding, paving materials, flora or
balloons, or any other similar building, landscaping or
decorative component.

5 "Executive board." The body, regardless of name, designated in the declaration to act on behalf of the association. 6 7 "Military flag." A flag of any branch of the United States Armed Forces or the Pennsylvania National Guard and POW/MIA 8 9 flags made of fabric, cloth or paper displayed from a staff or 10 flagpole or in a window. The term does not include a depiction 11 or emblem of a military flag made of lights, paint, roofing, siding, paving materials, flora or balloons, or any other 12 13 similar building, landscaping or decorative component. 14 "Unit owner." Any unit owner in a condominium or a planned 15 community, as defined in 68 Pa.C.S. § 3103 (relating to 16 definitions) and 5103 (relating to definitions), or in any 17 successor statute. The term shall include any proprietary lessee 18 in a cooperative, as defined in 68 Pa.C.S. § 4103 (relating to 19 definitions), or in any successor statute. COMMON INTEREST 20 COMMUNITY. 21 Section 3. Display of American flag, Commonwealth flag and

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21 Section 3. Display of American flag, Commonwealth flag and 22 military flag.

23 Notwithstanding any provision in the association's 24 declaration, covenants, bylaws, rules, regulations or other 25 instruments or any construction of any of those instruments by 26 an association's executive board, an association may not 27 prohibit the outdoor display of one American flag, Commonwealth 28 flag and military flag, by a unit owner on that unit owner's 29 property, but not on common elements in the community OR 30 PROPERTY WITHIN THE EXCLUSIVE CONTROL OF A UNIT OWNER OR THAT - 3 -20050S0082B1901

PORTION OF AN EXTERIOR WALL DIRECTLY ATTACHED TO THE UNIT, if 1 the American flag is displayed in a manner consistent with 4 2 3 U.S.C. §§ 4 (relating to pledge of allegiance to the flag; 4 manner of delivery) through 10 (relating to modification of 5 rules and customs by President) and a Commonwealth flag or military flag is displayed in accordance with any rules and 6 regulations adopted by the association. An association may adopt 7 rules and regulations, consistent with 4 U.S.C. §§ 4 through 10, 8 regarding the placement and manner of display of the American 9 10 flag, and an association may adopt rules and regulations 11 regarding the placement and manner of display of a Commonwealth flag or military flag. An association may adopt rules and 12 13 regulations regarding the location, size and use of a flagpole 14 but cannot prohibit the use of wall brackets to display the 15 American flag, Commonwealth flag and military flag. The size of 16 the American flag, Commonwealth flag and military flag to be 17 flown shall not be larger than five feet by three feet. In 18 addition, any rules and regulations adopted by the association 19 regarding the display of a military flag must permit the flying 20 of such flags, in a respectful way, on President's Day, Iwo Jima 21 Flag Raising Day, Vietnam Veterans Day, V-E Day, Armed Forces 22 Day, Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Korean War Veterans Armistice Day, V-J Day, Patriot's Day, POW/MIA 23 24 Recognition Day, Veterans Day, Pearl Harbor Day and the birthday of each branch of the United States Armed Forces. 25 26 Section 4. Effective date.

27 This act shall take effect in 30 days.
