AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth, providing for long-term
- 4 care insurance.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 8 as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 9 read:
- 10 Section 454. Long-Term Care Insurance.--It is declared to be
- 11 the policy of this Commonwealth to promote the development of
- 12 long-term care insurance as a cost-effective alternative to the
- 13 use of Federal and State moneys under Title XIX of the Social
- 14 Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. § 301 et seq.). In order
- 15 to effectuate this policy, the department is directed to take
- 16 <u>all reasonable and appropriate steps, including application to</u>
- 17 the Federal Government for necessary waivers, to modify the
- 18 medical assistance program in order to create incentives,

- 1 <u>including special income or resource levels and exemptions for</u>
- 2 recipient residents of long-term care facilities, in order to
- 3 <u>encourage the general population to purchase long-term care</u>
- 4 <u>insurance</u>. The department shall report annually to the General
- 5 Assembly regarding its efforts under this section on the first
- 6 three anniversaries of the effective date of this section.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
