has ever committed a sex offense in Pennsylvania.

- Strive to ensure the information contained on the Internet website is accurate and that the data therein is revised and updated as appropriate in a timely and efficient manner.
- Provide on the Internet website general information (5) designed to inform and educate the public about sex offenders and sexually violent predators and the operation of this subchapter as well as pertinent and appropriate information concerning crime prevention and personal safety, with appropriate links to other relevant Internet websites operated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
