Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 2 endangering the welfare of children. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 4304(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 8 § 4304. Endangering welfare of children. 9 (a) Offense defined. A parent, quardian, or other person 10 supervising the welfare of a child under 18 years of age or such person's employer or supervisor commits an offense if he 11 knowingly or recklessly endangers the welfare of the child by 12 violating a duty of care, protection or support. 13 * * * 14 15 (A) OFFENSE DEFINED. --(1) A PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR OTHER PERSON SUPERVISING THE 16 WELFARE OF A CHILD UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE OR A PERSON WHO 17

EMPLOYS OR SUPERVISES SUCH A PERSON COMMITS AN OFFENSE IF HE

- 1 KNOWINGLY OR RECKLESSLY ENDANGERS THE WELFARE OF THE CHILD BY
- 2 VIOLATING A DUTY OF CARE, PROTECTION OR SUPPORT.
- (2) A PERSON COMMITS AN OFFENSE IF THE PERSON, IN AN 3
- OFFICIAL CAPACITY, PREVENTS OR INTERFERES WITH THE MAKING OF 4
- 5 A REPORT OF SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE UNDER 23 PA.C.S. CH. 63
- 6 (RELATING TO CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES).
- 7 (3) AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE TERM "PERSON
- 8 SUPERVISING THE WELFARE OF A CHILD" MEANS A PERSON OTHER THAN
- 9 A PARENT OR GUARDIAN WHO PROVIDES CARE, EDUCATION, TRAINING
- 10 OR CONTROL OF A CHILD.

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
