## AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, imposing a central or 2 regional booking fee on criminal convictions to fund the 4 start-up, operation or maintenance of a central or regional 5 booking center. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 9 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 10 § 1725.5. Central or regional booking fee. 11 (a) Imposition. -- A person may, in addition to any other fines, penalties or costs imposed by law, be sentenced REQUIRED 12 BY THE COURT to pay a central or regional booking fee OF NO MORE 13 14 THAN \$200 if the person: 15 (1) Is placed on probation without verdict pursuant to 16 section 17 of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), 17 known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic

(2) Receives Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition for. 1 2 pleads quilty to or nolo contendere to, or is convicted of a 3 crime under the following: (i) 18 Pa.C.S. § 106(a) (relating to classes of 4 5 offenses). (ii) 75 Pa.C.S. § 3735 (relating to homicide by 6 7 vehicle while driving under influence). 8 (iii) 75 Pa.C.S. § 3802 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance). 9 (iv) A violation of The Controlled Substance, Drug, 10 Device and Cosmetic Act. 11 (b) Disposition. -- The fee under subsection (a) shall be paid 12 13 to the county and deposited into a special central or regional booking fund established in each county. Moneys in the special 14 fund shall be used solely for the start-up, operation or 15 16 maintenance of a central or regional booking center. 17 (c) Other laws. -- The central or regional booking fee shall

be imposed notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
