- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 magisterial district judges serving as arbitrators.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3304 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, amended November 30, 2004 (P.L.1618,
- 8 No.207), is amended to read:
- 9 § 3304. Acting as collection agent or paid arbitrator
- 10 prohibited.
- 11 (a) Collection agent.--No judge or magisterial district
- 12 judge shall act as agent for a person in the collection of a
- 13 claim or judgment for money.
- (b) Arbitrator.--[No] Except as provided in subsection (c),
- 15 <u>no</u> judge or magisterial district judge shall receive any fee or
- 16 emolument for performing the duties of an arbitrator.
- 17 (c) Arbitrator exception.--Except as may otherwise be
- 18 provided by general rule, the prohibition contained in

- 1 <u>subsection</u> (b) <u>shall not apply to a magisterial district judge</u>
- 2 serving as an arbitrator of any matter that cannot be properly
- 3 <u>commenced in the magisterial district judge's magisterial</u>
- 4 <u>district.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
