## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, defining "mounted specimen"; and further providing

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
