AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for reports and removal of 3 abandoned vehicles within the boundaries of a city of the 4 first class or second class; AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR 5 CONDITIONS OF PERMITS AND SECURITY FOR DAMAGES. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 7304.1 heading of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is 10 amended by adding a subsection to read: 11 SECTION 1. SECTION 4962(F.2) OF TITLE 75 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA 12 CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED TO READ: 13 § 4962. CONDITIONS OF PERMITS AND SECURITY FOR DAMAGES. * * * 14 15 (F.2) ONE PILOT CAR. -- VEHICLES GREATER THAN 13 FEET BUT LESS 16 THAN 14 FEET IN BODY WIDTH, EVEN IF THE TOTAL LENGTH OF THE

VEHICLE OR COMBINATION, INCLUDING THE LOAD ON THE COMBINATION,

- 1 EXCEEDS 90 FEET BUT IS NOT IN EXCESS OF 120 FEET, SHALL ONLY BE
- 2 REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN ONE PILOT CAR. THE POSITION OF THE PILOT
- 3 CAR TO THE FRONT OR REAR OF THE PERMITTED VEHICLE MAY BE
- 4 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
