Exceptions to sovereign immunity. * * * 10 11 (b) Acts which may impose liability. -- The following acts by a Commonwealth party may result in the imposition of liability 12 13 on the Commonwealth, and the defense of sovereign immunity shall not be raised to claims for damages caused by: 14 15 16 (4) Commonwealth real estate, highways and sidewalks.--A 17 dangerous condition of Commonwealth agency real estate, guide

rails and sidewalks, including Commonwealth-owned real
