AN ACT

Amending the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), 2 entitled "An act prohibiting unfair methods of competition 3 and unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of 4 any trade or commerce, giving the Attorney General and 5 District Attorneys certain powers and duties and providing 6 penalties, " providing for motor vehicle lessee protection. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law, 10 11 reenacted and amended November 24, 1976 (P.L.1166, No.260), is 12 amended by adding a section to read: 13 Section 9.4. Motor Vehicle Lessee Protection. -- (a) The lease of a motor vehicle is voidable at the option of the lessee 14 15 if the Department of Transportation recalls the operating privilege of the lessee under 75 Pa.C.S. § 1519 (relating to 16 determination of incompetency). A lease shall include a 17

- 1 (b) As used in this section:
- 2 <u>"Fleet lease" means a contract or other agreement between a</u>
- 3 <u>lessor and a lessee in which the vehicles are to be used</u>
- 4 primarily for business or commercial purposes and that is
- 5 either: a written agreement for the use of at least two vehicles
- 6 that includes an agreement for an option to use at least one
- 7 additional motor vehicle or a written agreement for the lease of
- 8 five or more vehicles.
- 9 <u>"Lease" means a contract or other agreement between a lessor</u>
- 10 and a lessee, other than a fleet lease, for the use of a motor
- 11 <u>vehicle</u> by the lessee for a period of time exceeding one hundred
- 12 twenty days, whether or not the lessee has the option to
- 13 purchase or otherwise become the owner of the motor vehicle at
- 14 the expiration of the lease.
- 15 <u>"Leasing dealer" means a person who in the ordinary course of</u>
- 16 <u>business offers or enters into motor vehicle leases or who in</u>
- 17 the course of any twelve-month period offers or enters into more
- 18 than three motor vehicle leases. The term shall not include a
- 19 person to whom a lease is assigned by a leasing dealer.
- 20 <u>"Lessee" means a person who leases a motor vehicle under a</u>
- 21 <u>lease.</u>
- 22 "Lessor" means a leasing dealer who holds title to a motor
- 23 vehicle leased to a lessee under a lease or a leasing dealer who
- 24 holds the lessor's rights under the lease or a person to whom a
- 25 lease is assigned.
- 26 <u>"Motor vehicle" or "vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined</u>
- 27 in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to definitions), except the living
- 28 <u>facilities of motor homes.</u>
- 29 Section 2. The addition of section 9.4 of the act shall
- 30 apply to contracts entered into on or after the effective date

- 1 of this act.
- 2 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
