AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further defining "superannuation age";
- and providing for a definition of "campus police officer."
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definition of "superannuation age" in section
- 7 5102 of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
- 8 amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to
- 9 read:
- 10 § 5102. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases as used in this part, unless
- 12 a different meaning is plainly required by the context, shall
- 13 have the following meanings:
- 14 * * *
- 15 <u>"Campus police officer." An employee of a university within</u>
- 16 the State System of Higher Education who is commissioned and
- 17 trained as a police officer according to section 2416 of the act

- 1 of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative
- 2 <u>Code of 1929.</u>
- 3 * * *
- 4 "Superannuation age." Any age upon accrual of 35 eligibility
- 5 points or age 60, except for a member of the General Assembly,
- 6 an enforcement officer, a correction officer, a psychiatric
- 7 security aide, a Delaware River Port Authority policeman, a
- 8 <u>campus police officer</u> or an officer of the Pennsylvania State
- 9 Police, age 50, and, except for a member with Class G, Class H,
- 10 Class I, Class J, Class K, Class L, Class M or Class N service,
- 11 age 55 upon accrual of 20 eligibility points.

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
