## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class 3 and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto, "further providing for 5 investment of moneys. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1.
