Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
    Consolidated Statutes, providing for duties of property
    owners in cities of the first class prior to installation of
    electric service.
    The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
    Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
$ 1512. Duty of property owners in cities of the first class
    prior to installation of electric service.
    In cities of the first class, real property owners who
request that a public utility install an additional electric
meter to measure the amount of electricity used in either a
portion or the whole of their property shall first provide
verifiable proof that the dwelling in which the additional meter
will be installed complies with the relevant local zoning
requirements regarding single and multifamily use of real
