10	Section 1. Section 201 of the act of November 24, 1998
11	(P.L.882, No.111), known as the Crime Victims Act, is amended by
12	adding a paragraph to read:
13	Section 201. Rights.
14	Victims of crime have the following rights:
15	* * *
16	(14) To confer with the attorney for the government
17	PROSECUTOR in the case at a reasonable time and manner.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
