## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing, in Allegheny Regional Asset District, for governing board and for capital budget.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 3111-B(a) of the act of July 28, 1953
- 10 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, added
- 11 December 22, 1993 (P.L.529, No.77), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 3111-B. Governing Board.--(a) The powers and duties
- 13 of the district shall be exercised by a board that reflects the
- 14 racial and ethnic diversity of the county and composed of the
- 15 following members:
- 16 (1) Four members <u>nominated</u> by the county executive and
- 17 appointed by the governing body of the county who shall serve
- at the pleasure of the governing body of the county. [and who

- 1 shall be selected in the following manner:
- 2 (i) Two members who shall be selected from nominations made
- 3 by the chairman of the board of county commissioners.
- 4 (ii) Two members who shall be selected from lists of
- 5 nominees submitted by the members of the board of county
- 6 commissioners other than the chairman. A separate list
- 7 containing at least three nominees shall be submitted by each of
- 8 the members of the board of county commissioners other than the
- 9 chairman. One member of the board of the district shall be
- 10 selected from each list of nominees.]
- 11 (2) Two members appointed by the mayor of the city who shall
- 12 serve at the pleasure of the mayor.
- 13 (3) One member appointed by the vote of at least five of the
- 14 members appointed pursuant to paragraphs (1) and (2) from a list
- 15 of nominees provided by regional economic and community
- 16 development organizations.
- 17 (4) One [nonvoting] member appointed by the Governor who
- 18 shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
- 19 (5) One member appointed by each of the following
- 20 <u>legislative caucus leaders who shall serve at the pleasure of</u>
- 21 the respective appointing authority with each such member being
- 22 referred to as a "legislative appointee":
- (i) The President pro tempore of the Senate.
- 24 (ii) The Minority Leader of the Senate.
- 25 (iii) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 26 (iv) The Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
- 27 The term of a legislative appointee shall coincide with the term
- 28 of the appointing authority.

- 30 Section 2. Section 3115-B of the act is amended by adding a

- subsection to read:
- Section 3115-B. Capital Budget.--\* \* \* 2
- 3 (b.1) An annual appropriation of two per centum (2%) of the
- 4 <u>funds made available to the district from sales and use taxes</u>
- 5 levied within the county shall be provided to the official
- 6 tourist promotion agency of the county for the purpose of
- carrying out the functions of the agency.

- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
