AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further prohibiting use of hearing impairment 3 devices. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 3314(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 § 3314. Prohibiting use of hearing impairment devices. 8 9 10 (b) [Exception] Exceptions. -- This section does not prohibit: [the] 11 12 (1) The use of hearing aids or other devices for 13 improving the hearing of the driver.[, nor does it prohibit 14 the] 15 (2) The use of a headset in conjunction with a cellular telephone that only provides sound through one ear and allows 16 17 surrounding sounds to be heard with the other ear[,].

Cellular telephone use is allowed only on highways having a

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
