AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, imposing sanctions and penalties on 3 employers who engage in the unlawful employment of aliens.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7331. Unlawful employment of aliens.
- 9 (a) Prohibition. -- An employer who is found by a court or
- 10 <u>administrative agency to have violated section 274A of the</u>
- 11 Immigration and Nationality Act (66 Stat. 163, 8 U.S.C. § 1324a)
- 12 shall be subject to the suspension or revocation of its business
- 13 or professional license by the applicable licensing authority in
- 14 addition to a fine as provided for in subsection (b).
- 15 (b) Penalty. -- Any employer who violates subsection (a) shall

- 1 be sentenced or ordered to pay a civil fine in the amount of
- 2 \$5,000.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
