AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 confidential communications to clergymen.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5943 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5943. Confidential communications to clergymen.
- 9 No clergyman, priest, rabbi, Christian Science practitioner
- 10 or minister of the gospel of any regularly established church or
- 11 religious organization, except clergymen or ministers[,] who are
- 12 self-ordained or who are members of religious organizations in
- 13 which members other than the leader thereof are deemed clergymen
- 14 or ministers, who while in the course of his duties has acquired
- 15 information from any person secretly and in confidence shall be
- 16 compelled, or allowed without consent of such person, to
- 17 disclose that information in any legal proceeding, trial or
- 18 investigation before any government unit.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
