## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- 3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," further providing, in
- 4 public assistance, for administration.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 403 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
- 8 No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, amended May 16, 1996
- 9 (P.L.175, No.35), is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 10 Section 403. Uniformity in Administration of Assistance;
- 11 Regulations as to Assistance. --\* \* \*
- (h) No general assistance shall be paid to an individual who
- 13 does not comply with the citizenship requirements of section
- 14 1903 of the Social Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. §

- 1 1903).
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
