26 Section 1. Section 10(ee) of the act of May 28, 1937 27 (P.L.955, No.265), known as the Housing Authorities Law, added

October 4, 1978 (P.L.1008, No.215), is amended to read: 1 2 Section 10. Powers of an Authority. -- An Authority shall 3 constitute a public body, corporate and politic, exercising 4 public powers of the Commonwealth as an agency thereof, which powers shall include all powers necessary or appropriate to 5 carry out and effectuate the purpose and provisions of this act, 6 including the following powers, in addition to others herein 7 8 granted:

In a city of the second or third class, to appoint 10 (ee) 11 police officers who shall have the same rights, powers and duties as other peace officers in the Commonwealth with respect 12 13 to the property and enforcing order on and adjacent to the grounds and buildings of the Authority: Provided, That said 14 15 police officers complete the same course of instruction as is 16 required for municipal police officers by the act of June 18, 17 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), referred to as the Municipal Police 18 Education and Training Law.
