12	authorized to establis	sh and maintain driver improvement	schools
13	throughout this Common	nwealth. The department may approve	and

14 conduct an annual review of the course material for the schools. 15 The curriculum to be presented must be uniform throughout this 16 Commonwealth <u>and shall include education on aggressive driving</u>. 17 All instructors shall be properly certified by the department 18 after the completion of a course of instruction approved by the 19 department.

22 § 3737. Aggressive driving.

23 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits the offense of

24 aggressive driving if the person operates a vehicle in a manner

- 25 which endangers or is likely to endanger the safety of another
- 26 person or property when the offense involves the commission of

27 two or more violations of the following sections in a single act

28 or series of acts in close proximity to another vehicle:

- 29 <u>Section 3112 (relating to traffic-control signals).</u>
- 30 <u>Section 3303 (relating to overtaking vehicle on the</u>

17	violating subsection (a) commits a summary offense and shall,
18	upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$300.
19	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
