## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of cruelty to animals.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 5511(h.1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 5511. Cruelty to animals.

10	(h.1) Animal fightingA person commits a felony of the
11	third degree if he:
12	(1) for amusement or gain, causes, allows or permits any
13	animal to engage in animal fighting;
14	(2) receives compensation for the admission of another

1 person to any place kept or used for animal fighting; 2 (3) owns, possesses, keeps, trains, promotes, purchases, 3 steals or acquires in any manner or knowingly sells any animal for animal fighting; 4 5 (4) in any way knowingly encourages, aids or assists therein; 6 7 wagers on the outcome of an animal fight; (5) 8 (6) pays for admission to an animal fight or attends an 9 animal fight as a spectator; or 10 (7) knowingly permits any place under his control or possession to be kept or used for animal fighting. 11 12 This subsection shall not apply to activity undertaken in a 13 normal agricultural operation. \* \* \* 14 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
