## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 17, 2007 (P.L. , No.8A), entitled, "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of 3 the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2007, to June 30, 2008, for certain institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, the Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores 10 Fund, the Milk Marketing Fund, the Home Investment Trust 11 12 Fund, the Emergency Medical Services Operating Fund, the 13 Tuition Payment Fund, the Banking Department Fund, the 14 Firearm Records Check Fund, the Ben Franklin Technology 15 Development Authority Fund and the Tobacco Settlement Fund to the Executive Department; to provide appropriations from the 16 Judicial Computer System Augmentation Account to the Judicial 17 18 Department for the fiscal year July 1, 2007, to June 30, 19 2008; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund 20 for the fiscal year July 1, 2007, to June 30, 2008, for the proper operation of the several departments of the 21 22 Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State Police authorized to 23 spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the 24 appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive Department of 25 the Commonwealth and for the payment of bills remaining 26 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007; 27 to provide for the additional appropriation of Federal and State funds from the General Fund, the State Lottery Fund and 28 the Pharmaceutical Assistance Contract for the Elderly Fund 29

- 10 by the State Treasurer and shall be
- 11 deposited into separate accounts for
- 12 the Legislative Management Committee
