## AN ACT

1	Amending the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), entitled
2	"An act reforming the law on medical professional liability;
3	providing for patient safety and reporting; establishing the
4 5	Patient Safety Authority and the Patient Safety Trust Fund; abrogating regulations; providing for medical professional
5 6	liability informed consent, damages, expert qualifications,
7	limitations of actions and medical records; establishing the
8	Interbranch Commission on Venue; providing for medical
9	professional liability insurance; establishing the Medical
10	Care Availability and Reduction of Error Fund; providing for
11	medical professional liability claims; establishing the Joint
12	Underwriting Association; regulating medical professional

16	Loan Fund eligibility; and making an appropriation.
17	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
18	hereby enacts as follows:
19	Section 1. The act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), known
20	as the Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare)
21	Act, is amended by adding a section to read:
22	Section 410.1. Machinery and Equipment Loan Fund eligibility.

23 (a) Funds available.--Up to \$25,000,000 of the funds

1	appropriated by the General Assembly for the Machinery and
2	Equipment Loan Fund for the purposes of this section shall be
3	made available for loans to health care facilities to assist in
4	acquiring technology systems that reduce health care-associated
5	infections. Loan and interest payments made by health care
6	facilities to the Machinery and Equipment Loan Fund as a result
7	of loans issued under this section shall be applied and
8	reapplied to the purposes of this section.
9	(b) ReservationOf the amount available under subsection
10	(a), \$10,000,000 shall be reserved exclusively for loans for
11	qualifying electronic surveillance systems that will reduce
12	health care-associated infections.
13	(c) LimitLoans awarded under this section shall not
14	exceed 50% of a health care facility's costs of acquisition and
15	must be approved by the Department of Community and Economic
16	Development and the department.
17	(d) CriteriaThe Department of Community and Economic
18	Development and the department shall jointly develop criteria
19	for evaluating applications for loans under this section that
20	consider the fiscal condition of the health care facility, the
21	ability of the health care facility to implement the technology
22	and the potential savings through avoided costs. The criteria
23	shall be forwarded by the department to the Legislative
24	<u>Reference Bureau for publication as a notice in the Pennsylvania</u>
25	<u>Bulletin.</u>
26	(e) Governing lawThe provisions of 12 Pa.C.S. Ch. 29
27	(relating to machinery and equipment loans) insofar as they are
28	consistent with the provisions of this section shall apply to
29	loans made under this section.
30	Section 2. The sum of \$25,000,000 is hereby appropriated to

 1, 2007, to June 30, 2008, to carry out the provisions of
 section 410.1 of the act.

4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
