- STANDARDS ADOPTED UNDER 12 PA. CODE § 145.41 (RELATING TO 7
- ADOPTION OF STANDARDS) AND WHICH IS WHOLLY OR IN SUBSTANTIAL 8
- PART MADE, CONSTRUCTED, FABRICATED, FORMED OR ASSEMBLED IN
- 10 MANUFACTURING FACILITIES FOR INSTALLATION OR ASSEMBLY AND
- 11 INSTALLATION ON THE BUILDING SITE SO THAT CONCEALED PARTS OR

- 24 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS FOR
- 25 INDUSTRIALIZED/COMMERCIAL MODULAR BUILDINGS AND IS AUTHORIZED TO
- 26 ENTER INTO A MULTI-STATE AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING
- 27 THE BUILDINGS.
