Section 4906(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 8 § 4906. False reports to law enforcement authorities. 9 10 (c) Grading. --(1) If the violation of subsection (b) refers to an 11 offense or incident relating to the loss or theft of a 12 firearm, as defined in section 6102 (relating to 13 definitions), the offense shall be graded a misdemeanor of 14 15 the first degree. 16 (2) If the violation of subsection (a) or (b) occurs 17 during a declared state of emergency and the false report

- diverted from dealing with the declared state of emergency,
- 2 the offense shall be graded one step greater than that set
- 3 forth in the applicable subsection.
- 4 Section 2. The addition of 18 Pa.C.s. § 4906(c)(1) shall

- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
