AN ACT

Amending the act of May 29, 1956 (1955 P.L.1804, No.600), 1 2 entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the establishment of police pension funds or pension annuities in certain 3 4 boroughs, towns and townships; authorizing the establishment 5 of police pension funds or pension annuities by regional police departments; providing for the regulation and б maintenance of police pension funds or pension annuities; 7 providing for an actuary; continuance of existing funds or 8 9 transfer thereof to funds herein established; prescribing 10 rights of beneficiaries; contributions by members; providing for expenses of administration; continuation of existing 11 authority to provide annuity contracts; credit for military 12 13 service; refunds; exempting allowances from judicial process; 14 and repealing certain acts," further providing for the 15 calculation of cost-of-living increases.

16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

17 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 5(g) of the act of May 29, 1956 (1955)
P.L.1804, No.600), referred to as the Municipal Police Pension
Law, amended February 18, 1998 (P.L.155, No.24), is amended to
read:

22 Section 5. * * *

1 (g) (1) The ordinance or resolution establishing the police pension fund may provide for a cost of living increase for 2 3 members of the police force receiving retirement benefits. The 4 cost of living increase shall not exceed the percentage increase 5 in the Consumer Price Index from the year in which the police member last worked, shall not cause the total police pension 6 7 benefits to exceed seventy-five per centum of the salary for computing retirement benefits and shall not cause the total cost 8 9 of living increase to exceed thirty per centum. No cost of 10 living increase shall be granted which would impair the 11 actuarial soundness of the pension fund.

12 (2) (i) Subject to the limitations in clause (ii), if the 13 assets of the police pension fund exceed the present value of 14 future benefits as reported in the last actuarial valuation 15 report filed with the Public Employee Retirement Commission 16 under the act of December 18, 1984 (P.L.1005, No.205), known as 17 the "Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act," 18 a cost of living increase for members of the police force receiving retirement benefits for twenty or more years may be 19 20 provided in excess of the limits herein prescribed.

21 (ii) If the total benefits to be paid to a retired member 22 from the police pension fund exceed ten thousand dollars 23 (\$10,000) a year, then the police pension fund shall not pay 24 benefits to a retired member in excess of one hundred per centum 25 of the retired member's average compensation based on the 26 monthly average salary of such member based on the member's last 27 thirty-six months of employment or as defined in section 415 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. 28 § 415) or in any successor statute, whichever calculation 29 30 produces the higher benefit to a retired member under this 20080H2712B4215 - 2 -

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
