- 4 WHEREAS, Ryan Howard, first baseman for the Philadelphia
- 5 Phillies, was awarded the 2006 National League Most Valuable
- 6 Player Award by the Baseball Writers' Association of America;

- 8 WHEREAS, Ryan Howard has earned recognition for leading the
- 9 Major League in both home runs and runs batted in, with 58
- 10 homers and 149 RBIs, as well as having an impressive .313
- 11 batting average; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Ryan Howard became only the second player in Major

- 1 League Baseball history to win the Rookie of the Year Award and
- 2 Most Valuable Player Award in consecutive seasons; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In his first full season as a major leaguer, Ryan
- 4 Howard made his first Major League All-Star Game appearance; and
- 5 WHEREAS, At the Major League All-Star Game, Ryan Howard
- 6 slammed his way to a victory in the Home Run Derby; and
- WHEREAS, Ryan Howard's 58 home runs shattered the
- 8 Philadelphia Phillies franchise record for home runs in a season
- 9 held by Hall of Fame third baseman Mike Schmidt, the last
- 10 Philadelphia Phillies player to win the Most Valuable Player
- 11 Award; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the
- 13 accomplishments of Ryan Howard on the occasion of winning the
- 14 2006 National League Most Valuable Player Award and extend its
- 15 best wishes for future success in his baseball career.
