- 12 WHEREAS, UPS delivers more than 800,000 packages every day to
- 13 customers across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, connecting
- 14 people, communities and businesses; and

- 2 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to more than 200 countries
- 3 through its expansive transportation network that truly
